Angels and Ministers And Other Victorian Plays By Laurence Housman Classic Victorian Drama Laurence Housman; 18 July 1865 - 20 February 1959) was an English playwright, writer and illustrator. Laurence Housman was born in Bromsgrove, Worcestershire, one of seven children who included the poet A. E. Housman and writer Clemence Housman. In 1871 his mother died, and his father remarried, to a cousin. After education at Bromsgrove School, he went with his sister Clemence to study art at the Lambeth School of Art and the Royal College of Art in London. When his eyesight began to fail, he turned more and more to writing. Housman's first literary success came with the novel An Englishwoman s Love-letters (1900), published anonymously. He then turned to drama with Bethlehem (1902) and was to become best known and remembered as a playwright. His other dramatic works include Angels and Ministers (1921), Little Plays of St. Francis (1922) and Victoria Regina (1934) which was even staged on Broadway. Housman's play, Pains and Penalties, about Queen Caroline, was produced by Edith Craig...
