

I was born in 1928, on the eve of the Great Depression and so not a good year, but for me it was a very good year: I missed the First World War and as the Second World War finished in 1945, I was too young to fight. In 1938, during the Kristallnacht, our Modesalon on the Kurfurstendamm in Berlin was destroyed, and my mother fled to England. I was the youngest in the family, and my mother took me with her, while my brother Erik was left behind and ended up in a Nazi Zwangsarbeitslager. Sadly, all my mother s relatives left in Germany died in Nazi concentration camps. In England my luck continued. At first I lived with Mr Mrs Clamp and they treated me as if I were their own child. English became my first language; in 1940 I went to Ashby Boys Grammar School. In 1942 I moved to London. I wanted to study medicine and applied to do 1st MB at Chelsea Polytechnic and was only offered a place on their pre-1stMB course, not what I wanted. When on the first day I had my interview with one of the tutors and he saw my School Certificate results he said: I see from your exam results that in the Pre-1st MB course you would be repeating what you have already done at school, so I am transferring you to the 1st MB course. In June 1945 I passed this exam. I applied to all the...
